EXISTING GATE ACCESS CARDS WILL NOT WORK AFTER 11/26/2007

Installation of our new vehicle gate access system is complete. We will switch to the new system by turning off the old card readers and turning on the new ones at 8am, Nov. 26th, the Monday after Thanksgiving.

If you currently have a card and your information is complete and up to date, you will automatically receive a new card via mail. If you have not received your new card by Nov. 9th, call or stop by the airport office anytime Mon.-Fri., between 8-4:30 to obtain your new access card.

Current cardholders will not be charged for the new card. However, replacements for lost cards and new original issue cards will cost \$25 each.
