Check NOTAMs carefully before flying over the weekend of the Fourth. There will be several restricted areas to avoid with all the airshow aerobatic boxes, fireworks on the riverfront and GCS Ballpark, and sporting event TFRs.

**GRIZZLIES' FIREWORKS**

Use caution for fireworks displays at GCS Stadium after the games on July 3 and 4. See our Airspace and Runway NOTAMs before flying.

**CHANGED ATC PROCEDURES**

FAA Air Traffic Organization Policy on taxi instructions changed July 1, 2010. An explicit runway crossing clearance is now required for each runway to be crossed and an aircraft/vehicle must have crossed the previous runway before another runway crossing may be issued.

As examples, aircraft located on the west ramp should receive a specific clearance to cross runway 5/23 if going to either of the other runways. Also, if an aircraft is directed to runway 30L from the west ramp by taxiway A, A4, B4, B to hold short of runway 30L at B7, expect the controller to clear you to cross runway 5/23 and hold short of runway 12L/30R. Only after crossing runway 5/23, can they then clear you to cross runway 12L/30R.

**NEW SERVICE ROAD OPEN SOON**

The new interior service road around the north end of Runway 5/23 will be completed later this month. The narrow roadway will allow fuel trucks and other airport service vehicles to travel between the two aircraft parking ramps without having to cross the runway.

Use of the road will be restricted to authorized airport service vehicles only—absolutely no privately-owned cars, trucks, golf carts, scooters, bicycles or pedestrians!
