SECURE YOUR HANGAR DOORS

Recent wind storms highlighted the need to secure hangar doors using all available locks. Several T-hangars were discovered with the main hangar doors unsecured and gapping open in the wind. To prevent damage to the doors and perhaps your aircraft inside, ensure all doors are securely closed and locked.
