The Cahokia Area Chamber of Commerce is hosting an electronics recycling day on Saturday, April 20th, at the Cahokia Fitness Center (formerly the YMCA on the old Parks College Campus), on Camp Jackson Road.

The following items will be accepted FREE for environmentally friendly recycling: Computer components; electric motors; DVD players; laptop computers; batteries; speakers; VHS recorders; modems; cell phones; wire; small refrigerators; washers; dryers; dishwashers; small freezers; and other small appliances such as blenders, mixers, and bread machines.

There will be a \$5 fee for small televisions and computer monitors and \$10 for large TVs.
