WARNINGS AND NOTAMS

Use caution for a wide variety of aircraft flying around the airport and riverfront area.

MON., JULY 1:

B-17 Flying Fortress begins air tour operations.

WED., JULY 3:

1145-1430: Avoid the active Aerobatic Box over the Gateway Arch Riverfront.

2030-2200: Runway 12L/30R Closed due to fireworks at Grizzlies' GCS Ballpark.

THUR., JULY 4:

1145-1400 and 1600-1800: Avoid the Riverfront Aerobatic Box.

FRI. JULY 5:

1200-1400: AIRPORT CLOSED to all except airshow, emergency, life flight, military, and law enforcement aircraft.

1200-1400 and 1600-1800: Riverfront Aerobatic Box.

1815-2245: Baseball TFR over Busch Stadium.

2030-2200: Runway 12L/30R Closed due to fireworks at Grizzlies' GCS Ballpark.

SAT. JULY 6:

1200-1400: AIRPORT CLOSED to all except airshow, emergency, life flight, military, and law enforcement aircraft. A special air show will be conducted over the airport during this time for Fans with Special Needs. We could still use a few more volunteers. If interested, call the airport office.

1215-1700: Baseball TFR over Busch Stadium.

1700-1830: Aerobatic Box over the Riverfront.
